**SUGGESTED DONATIONS FOR SENIOR AND ADULT SERVICES
IN-HOME SUPPORTIVE SERVICES RECIPIENTS**

The Sacramento County In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) program provides supportive services to eligible aged, blind, or permanently disabled persons with extraordinary care needs who are unable to perform activities of daily living and cannot remain safely in their own homes without assistance.

IHSS social workers and public health nurses have identified the following items as being needed by their clients who either do not have the funds to pay themselves or if it is a Medi-Cal funded item, such as durable medical equipment, then authorization can be difficult and lengthy to obtain despite the client's immediate need for the assistance.

- Ensure
- Wheelchairs (if used please be in good working condition)
- Shower Wands
- Walkers and canes (if used please be in good working condition)
- Bed linens
- Towels
- Shower Chairs (if used please be in good working condition)
- Toiletry items i.e. toothbrushes, toothpaste, denture cleaners, soap, lotion
- Depends – adult diapers
- Gift cards for food (our family service workers deliver food to those in need) or for other essentials such as clothing.
- Fans (new only)
